Friday, January 29, 2021 – Last day to return texts without having dropped the class

Friday, March 5, 2021 – Last day to return textbooks

TEXTBOOK RETURN POLICY:

- There is a **20% restocking fee** for any textbook returned unless the class has been dropped.
Verification of a dropped class must be obtained from Bookstore staff.
- All returns must be accompanied by a sales receipt and **in the same condition as when purchased.**
- Texts may only be returned in the semester in which they were purchased.
- There will be no exceptions to this policy.

*** Make sure to purchase all of your Fall semester textbooks before the dates below!**

The Bookstore must return...

all unsold USED books to publishers by **Friday, March 12, 2021**

all unsold NEW books to publishers by **Friday, April 16, 2021**

TEXTBOOK RENTAL AGREEMENT

RENTAL BOOKS MUST BE RETURNED IN THE SAME CONDITION with exception of reasonable highlighting and writing.

If you choose to rent a book you will be entering into a rental agreement with our bookstore to loan you one copy of a selected title. Rental textbooks are the intellectual property of the author(s) and are copyrighted by the author(s) or publishers. Textbook rentals are not to be reproduced. The rental agreement is only effective for the current semester (unless otherwise noted). Per terms of this agreement, you are responsible for the following:

1. I am renting the book listed above. I have paid the rental fee, and understand the application of the Whitman Bookstore return policy as it applies to rental fee refunds. I acknowledge that the book, whether it is new or used, is in good condition.
2. If I drop a class, I understand the book **MUST** be returned by **Friday, March 5, 2021**, to be eligible for a refund.
3. I will return the book to the Whitman Bookstore no later than **Wednesday, May 18, 2021**. If I ship the book, it will be at my own expense, and it must be received, with my name and student number, no later than **Wednesday, May 18, 2021, at 4:00 PM**. **Any rental returns after this date will be rejected and will be billed as described in number 7 below.**
4. I will return the book in good condition as determined by the Whitman Bookstore. All CDs and other component parts included with the book must also be present and in good condition. Reasonable highlighting and writing will be accepted.
5. I am responsible for risk of loss, theft, and damage.
6. I am responsible for the purchase of a book returned in unsalable condition, such as but not limited to those damaged by liquids, fire, chemical spills, tooth marks, missing components, bent corners, creased pages and spine damage.
7. If I fail to return the textbook by the return date, I understand I will pay the Whitman Bookstore the replacement cost, which will be determined as the original selling price minus the rental fee already paid and applicable taxes. **I authorize the Whitman Bookstore to charge the credit card I secured the rental with. In the event the card cannot be charged, I authorize Whitman Bookstore to charge these charges to my Whitman student account.**
8. I understand if I have an outstanding textbook rental fine I will not be allowed to rent textbooks until the fines are paid in full.
9. Should I wish to buy the book at the end of the semester, I will declare to do so by **Wednesday, May 18, 2021, at 4:00 PM** and pay the full price of the new or used book at the time it was rented minus the rental fee already paid.
